Many thanks to Charlene and David for hosting us in their beautiful backyard. It was an afternoon of great food, great weather, and even better company!

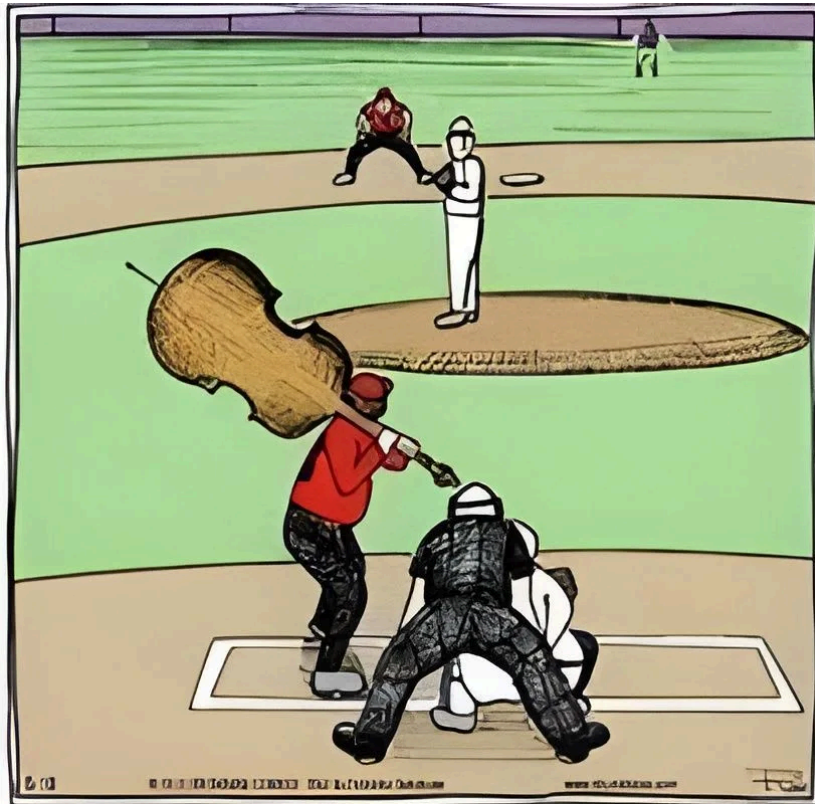
